The achievement, pass and retention rate for frameworks has remained very stable, despite Covid disruption. Note: If the apprentice gets to the end of the course, they very nearly always pass (98.5%). Leavers and drop-out falls as frameworks are phased/forced out by government.

Like for frameworks, apprentices that complete the standard nearly always pass (97.8%) but the retention rate was 17 percentage points lower, at just 53%, than for frameworks. Dropout rises sharply 65% to 96,190 as government policy forces apprentices to choose standards instead of frameworks.

Further insights: So where is the biggest retention rate (drop out) problem for standards?

Level 3 has the highest number of drop outs, but level 2 has the highest drop out rate, with a just over a half of all apprentices dropping out before the end of the course.

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
